# OUR LEARNING

Our topic this term is **Dynamic Dynasties**, where we'll journey through ancient China and the Shang Dynasty. Children will explore Shang writing, oracle bones, beliefs, warfare, and key figures like Fu Hao, before considering the dynasty's legacy. Later, we'll study the Maya civilisation, comparing their achievements with those of the Shang.

#### MATHS

In maths we will be looking at place value, including negative numbers and decimal fractions. The four operations (+-x÷) and our times tables.

### ENGLISH

Our fiction book this term will be Running on the Roof of the World by Jess Butterworth.

In writing, we will be focusing on poetry, diary entries, biographies and a story narrative, which uses the writing style of third person.
