



Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 3 – Spring Term 4

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts with speed and accuracy:

I know the multiplication and division facts
for the three times table.

Children should be able to instantly recall
the 3 times table facts below:

$1 \times 3 = 3$	$3 \div 3 = 1$
$2 \times 3 = 6$	$6 \div 3 = 2$
$3 \times 3 = 9$	$9 \div 3 = 3$
$4 \times 3 = 12$	$12 \div 3 = 4$
$5 \times 3 = 15$	$15 \div 3 = 5$
$6 \times 3 = 18$	$18 \div 3 = 6$
$7 \times 3 = 21$	$21 \div 3 = 7$
$8 \times 3 = 24$	$24 \div 3 = 8$
$9 \times 3 = 27$	$27 \div 3 = 9$
$10 \times 3 = 30$	$30 \div 3 = 10$
$11 \times 3 = 33$	$33 \div 3 = 11$
$12 \times 3 = 36$	$36 \div 3 = 12$

Top tips

- Write down the multiples of three on cards to hide. Ask your child to find e.g. 7×3 .
